Strategies for sharing information with families

- Bulletin board or other display
- Information included in your program's handbook for families
- Information included in monthly newsletters
- Handouts sent home with children
- System for families to check-out books and articles on specific topics
- Information shared during meetings and conferences

This will also be documented during your YPQI assessments on the **Program Review Checklist**.
