

Informed by child count data and community needs, Local Leads will be responsible for completing a **Coordinated Funding Request (CFR) in February 2025** to request funding/seat allocations for their communities. The Local Lead will coordinate with sites and agencies to complete the CFR.

#### CFR will include requests for 2025-2026:

- Infant/Toddler Contracted Seats
- Arkansas Better Chance (ABC) Seats
- Federal Pre-K Seats
- ABC Home Visiting: PAT and HIPPY
- Early Head Start-Child Care Partnership (EHS-CCP)
