

Winter is upon us and that isn't going to stop children from playing outside. Here are some helpful tips to keep children safe this winter:

- 1. Dress infants and children warmly for outdoor activities.
 - Dressing children in several thin layers is recommended for optimal warmth. A
 good rule of thumb from the <u>American Academy of Pediatrics</u> is to dress
 children in one more layer than an adult would wear in the same conditions.
 Ask your client-families to pack additional clothing, if necessary, for their child
 to remain warm while playing outside this winter.

2. Utilize winter accessories.

 Boots, gloves, and a hat go a long way in keeping children warm alongside thin layers and a coat. Ask your client-families to bring these items with them at drop-off.
