Better Beginnings encourages families and providers to work on children's fine motor skills to prepare them for writing as part of National Handwriting Day.

LITTLE ROCK, Ark. (January 17, 2022) – <u>Better Beginnings</u>, a program of the Department of Human Services Division of Child Care and Early Childhood Education, has resources for families and providers to help their children develop the fine motor skills they need to be successful writers.

This is a way for families and providers to mark National Handwriting Day, which is Sunday, January 23.

"Before a child can properly hold any writing instrument, they must build up the necessary muscles in their hands and fingers," said Kelli Hilburn, Better Beginnings Program Administrator. "That takes practice."

There are many activities children can do to build those fine motor skills. The activities provided by Better Beginnings are built around play because that is how children learn. These activities include:

- Shaping and rolling playdough.
- Threading and tweezing activities.
- Using a clothes pin to pick up objects.
